The Master of Physiotherapy in Cardiopulmonary Science (MPT. Cardiopulmonary), is a two years postgraduate Physiotherapy degree level course. The course develops candidates as qualified and experienced clinicians able to broaden and deepen their theoretical, clinical skill with strong communication skill, influencing practices and service delivery in the area of Cardiopulmonary Physiotherapy.

The course of study is designed to provide in-depth knowledge, information, techniques and about the activities associated with Physiotherapy in Cardiopulmonary discipline, in a comprehensive manner. The study is focused on theoretical and practical aspects and principles of techniques in an academic discipline such as Medical and Surgical Management of Disorder of the Cardiopulmonary System, Physiotherapy Management in Disorder of the Cardiopulmonary System, Research Methodology and Biostatistics, Management / Administration and Ethical Issues, Biomechanics.

RULES:

Rules governing the admission to post-graduate physiotherapy courses at college of Physiotherapy, IKDRC-ITS.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1.1. He/ She must be an Indian Citizen. He/ She must be medically fit. He/ she should be registered in NCAHP.**
- 1.2. The candidate must have completed the recognized B. physiotherapy with minimum 50 % marks and compulsory rotating internship of six months before the date of first counselling. All candidates shall have to submit the documentary proof from the Principal / Dean of college regarding the date of completion of internship along with the application, failing which their application shall be summarily rejected. However candidate should have to produce full internship completion certificate at the time of counselling, failing which, candidate will not be eligible for admission.
- 1.3. A candidate who is engaged (at the time of submission of application) in P.G Physiotherapy studies in this University or any Other University or equivalent body is not eligible.
- 1.4. A candidate who in the past had been selected and admitted to any P.G. Physiotherapy course of this or any other university or equivalent body and did not complete that course at the time of submission of application, is not eligible.
- 1.5. A candidate who had applied earlier to this University and who was disqualified because of reason mentioned in Rules 6.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.10, is not eligible.
- 1.6. A candidate who is a graduate shall have to submit provisional eligibility certificate (P.E.C.)/Migration certificate from Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences within one month from the date of his / her admission, failing which the admission of candidate shall be cancelled without any notice thereof, fees forfeited and will not be eligible to apply in future. This provisional eligibility certificate (PEC) should be submitted to IKDRC-ITS College of Physiotherapy.
- 1.7. A candidate has to appear in Competitive examination conducted in respective academic year for admission to Post graduate Physiotherapy courses held by Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences.
- 2. Total seats of college will be allotted for open competition based purely on merit where inter-se merit will be assessed on the basis of combination of Entrance Examination and cumulative performance at under graduate examinations.**
 - 2.1 Counseling for the seats/students will be done by Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences.

3. Seats can be utilized in the same academic year only and any vacancy cannot be utilized in subsequent academic year.
4. The admissions will be as per reservation policy of Government of Gujarat.
- 4.1. In case non-availability of SC/ST/SEBC candidates, they shall be treated as unreserved seats of Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences and will be filled up by the candidates eligible for open merit seats on the basis of merit in respective quota seats.
- 4.2. Candidate seeking admission under rule 5.0 will have to produce the caste certificate from the competent authority as prescribed by the Government of Gujarat from time to time, and submit it along with the application. The candidate will not be allowed to change the caste category thereafter.
- 4.3. In case of any doubt or discrepancy about the caste certificate, decision of the Director, social welfare, Gujarat state shall be final.
5. **Application:** Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences conducting admission process will issue notice inviting application for admission under these rules. Candidate are required to submit the prescribed forms duly completed with receipt of entrance examination fee within the prescribed time limit.
- 6.1 The application form should be complete in all respects before submission. No alteration or addition will be permitted later on.
- 6.2 Every candidate will be issued a receipt when he/she submits application form. This must be preserved for all future references and produced when asked for and at the time of entrance examination and counselling.
- 6.3 If any candidate wishes to claim admission for other than open category seats, he should submit details with relevant documents along with application. However, he/she is not required to pay additional examination fee.
- 6.4 Counseling and entrance examination date / time / place will be notified in the notice inviting application or on official website. No separate notice or individual letters will be sent. The applicant should remain present on the day and time fixed for the same. The candidates should have to remain present until entire process of counseling is completed to get benefit of seat/s conversion from one category to another category. (However, in case a candidate is unable to appear in person on the day of Admission counseling, candidate may send his/her authorized representative with an Authority Letter attached

with application Form for allotment of seat along with required original documents and fees. The allotment made to authorized representative shall be binding on the candidate.)

6.5 (a) If any of the statements made in the application form or any information /marks/document supplied by the candidate in connection with his / her application for admission is later on found to be false or incorrect or misleading or if it is found that the candidate has concealed any information/ fact in connection with his / her application, his / her admission and registration shall be cancelled without any notice thereof, fees forfeited, have to pay the whole course fees, have to pay penalty of university, and he / she may be expelled and prosecuted, and he / she will not be eligible to apply in future.

(b) The candidate should verify his/her eligibility for appearance at the Entrance examination and Post Graduate Physiotherapy Admission. If through mistakes/error the forms are accepted and through mistake/error candidates appear in Entrance examination and admitted in Post Graduate Physiotherapy course, such candidate if found later to be ineligible, cannot claim any right or interest arising out of acceptance of form or appearance at the Entrance examination or admission in Post Graduate Physiotherapy course.

6.6 A Candidate, who has given entrance examination, found ineligible for the admission, then his/her result / admission shall be cancelled.

6.Determination of Merit Order.

Separate merit list for each category shall be prepared for the candidate eligible for admission to Gujarat University of transplantation sciences.

6.1. (A) Entrance Examinations:

1. There will be one paper of 1 hour duration for P.G. Physiotherapy courses Containing 100 multiple choice questions (MCQs) from B. Physiotherapy subjects.
2. The questions will be single response objective type. Each answer with correct response shall be awarded two marks. Zero mark will be given for the question not answered or incorrectly answered. More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect response and will be zero marked.
3. The examination shall be conducted in ENGLISH medium only.
4. There is no provision for rechecking /re-evaluation of the answer sheets and no query in this regard will be entertained. For any query regarding MCQ and/or Answer key, decisions of Subject expert/s will be final and it will be abide to all the Candidates.
5. The examination will be conducted as per program shown in notice of official website.

6. Candidates are expected to take their seats 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Please note that the candidate will not be allowed to enter into the examination hall or for the personal counselling without valid identity card in original.
7. Candidate who comes after 15 minutes of the commencement of the examination shall not be permitted to appear in the examination.
8. No candidate shall be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written bits of papers or any other material except the identity card (without envelop) inside the hall. If a Candidate is found to be coping/conversing with other candidate/to have in his /her possession paper, notes or books, or any other material, he/she shall be disqualified from taking examination and the next one or two such Examinations and necessary action to be taken as per GUTS rules and regulations.
9. No Candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of 1 (One) hour. Question paper, Answer Sheet, Rough work sheet etc. must be returned before leaving the examination hall.
10. The Candidate shall maintain silence and attend to their papers only. Any disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and the candidate's right to continue to write the examination will be forfeited. The decision of the center supervisor shall be final and conclusive.
11. Cellular Phones, Pagers, calculators, or any other electronic device/s which can relay and / or receive verbal / nonverbal images /text etc. are strictly prohibited in examination hall.

7.1 (B) Undergraduate Examination Marks:

- (i) Percentage up to 2 decimals of marks obtained by the candidate at Final Physiotherapy Examination (without internal marks). The percentage up to 2 decimal of marks obtained at Final Physiotherapy will be modified by deduction of 1.5 for each unsuccessful trial in the examination
- (ii) Percentage up to 2 decimals of marks obtained by the candidate at Third Physiotherapy Examination (without internal marks). The percentage up to 2 decimal of marks obtained at Third Physiotherapy will be modified by deduction of 1.5 for each unsuccessful trial in the examination.
- (iii) Percentage up to 2 decimals of marks obtained by the candidate at Second Physiotherapy Examination (without internal marks). The percentage up to 2 decimal of marks obtained at Second Physiotherapy will be modified by deduction of 1.5 for each unsuccessful trial in the examination.
- (iv) Percentage up to 2 decimals of marks obtained by the candidate at First Physiotherapy Examination (without internal marks). The percentage up to 2 decimal of marks obtained at First Physiotherapy will be modified by deduction of 1.5 for each unsuccessful trial in

the examination.

- (v) Total of (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) shall be considered as undergraduate examination marks.

7.2 (a) Merit list for admission: Total of 50% of marks obtained in Entrance Examination and 50% of cumulative marks obtained in under graduate examinations will be considered for merit/as minimum requirement for admission.

(b) Determination of inter-se-merit of candidates obtaining equal merit marks shall be determined in order of preference as under.

- (i) Candidate's higher marks in undergraduate examination.
- (ii) Candidate's higher marks in Final year B. Physiotherapy (Modified % up to 2 decimal)
- (iii) Candidate's higher marks in Third year B. Physiotherapy. (Modified % up to 2 decimal)
- (iv) Candidate's higher marks in Second year B. Physiotherapy. (Modified % up to 2 decimal)
- (v) Candidate's higher marks in First year B. Physiotherapy. (Modified % up to 2 decimal)
- (vi) According to age, older candidate will get preference over younger candidate.

7.3 Notification: Merit list will be notified/display as under:

Merit list - 1.1 Candidates eligible for Open Merit (Unreserved) seats.

Merit list - 1.2 Candidates eligible for SC seats belonging to SC category.

Merit list - 1.3 Candidates eligible for ST seats belonging to ST category.

Merit list - 1.4 Candidates eligible for SEBC seats belonging to SEBC category.

Merit list - 1.5 Candidates eligible for EWS seats belonging to EWS category.

7.4 These Merit Lists will be placed on the notice board of official website.

7.5 The candidate belonging to the SC/ST/SEBC for whom reservation is made and who takes admission on open merit will be counted against non-reserved seats.

7.6 A candidate of any category who remains absent or withdraws from counselling or does not opt for any admission, his/her admission will be cancelled.

7.7 All P.G. courses are full-time and the candidate shall not indulge in any type of private practice or employment of any nature (Part-time, paid or stipendiary or unpaid) during the course. If the candidate is employed, he shall have to produce proof that he has left the service or taken leave for full period of the course before joining the course. If violation of this condition is detected any time after the admission, his / her admission and registration shall be cancelled without any notice thereof, fees forfeited, have to pay the whole course fees,

have to pay penalty of university he / she may be expelled and prosecuted, and he / she will not be eligible to apply in future.

7.8 The selected and admitted candidate will have to join within prescribed time limit decided by Admission Cell. If he/she fails to do so as well as if he leaves before completion of the course, his / her admission and registration shall be cancelled without any notice thereof, fees forfeited, have to pay the whole course fees, have to pay penalty of university, and he / she will not be eligible to apply in future.

7.9 For granting of each term, candidate shall attend minimum 80% of the imparted training during each academic term.

7.10 A Candidate who fails four times in Postgraduate examination will have to go back and study for full one year under his/her own teacher. Then only the candidate will be permitted to appear in post graduate examination for maximum two trial and if candidate does not clear his/her Post graduate examination then his/her admission/registration will be permanently cancelled.

7.11 If any Post graduate student is found absent for more than 72 hours (before the last date for Completion of entire Admission process as per rule 3) and 15 days (after the last date for Completion of entire Admission process as per rule 3) without leave/ permission / information of competent authority, his / her admission and registration shall be cancelled without any notice thereof, fees forfeited, have to pay the whole course fees, have to pay penalty of university, he / she will not be eligible to apply in future.

7.12 If Candidate is admitted and does not join the course or leaves the course after Counselling, in such conditions, or in case of implementation of rules 1.3, 1.5, 1.7, 6.5, 7.8, 7.10, 7.12, following conditions will be imposed on the Candidate.

(Candidate will be required to give the undertaking that he/she shall abide by all the below mentioned conditions.)

- (i) His / Her admission and registration shall be cancelled without any notice thereof.
- (ii) Candidate will not eligible for future admission in the Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences.
- (iii) Candidates have to pay the course fees of all the year/academic terms.
- (iv) All deposit amount, Admission fees, tuition fees and university fees are forfeited and Candidate cannot claim on it.

8. At the time of counselling, Candidate will be required to give the undertaking stating that he/she is not admitted/engaged in PG Physiotherapy course anywhere else.

9. The University reserves the right to introduce any new Rule or Regulation or to make changes in any of the existing Rules or Regulations at any time to deal with diverse problems arising out of infinite variety of situations.

Regulation under Rule

Sequence of Interview for Selection and Admission

- R.1** Before the candidate is offered choice of post, his/her original documents are compared with the attested copies he/she had submitted with his/her application form. If all the originals are not available with him/her or if there is discrepancy in any of the documents, he/she may become ineligible, his/her counseling will not be held and next candidate will be called.
- R.2** If all attested copies of his/her documents are found to be exact copies of originals, he/she will be offered the Seat. If he/she chooses the Seat, he/she is asked to pay the fees / deposit and to submit the original documents. After the payment of fees / deposit and submission of original documents, his/her admission order will be prepared. Inability to pay requisite fees and deposit and submission of original documents to authority will render him/her ineligible and the next candidate will be called.
- R.3** A candidate who is absent when called, but reports late, will be eligible for admission and will be offered seat available at that time.
- R.4** Unless the counselling of one candidate is over, the next candidate is not called. Counselling is considered over if:
- (i) He/she has chosen the subject/ course / college/teacher/unit, paid fees and deposit, submitted original documents and his admission order is ready.
 - (ii) He/she has declined to take any of the Seats offered (withdraw).
 - (iii) He/she is ineligible under R.1 or R.2
- R.5** Admission orders are handed over to the candidates who are admitted. These orders are withheld for those who are employed, till proof is produced to the effect that he/she has left service or taken requisite leave and have actually handed over charge.
- R.6** Original mark sheets and other documents etc. of admitted candidates should be retained
By authority.
- R.7** Original Documents will be verified before giving Admission Order/Joining as follows.

1. Internship Completion Certificate, Mark sheet, Attempt Certificate, School Leaving Certificate,
2. Registration certificate from the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions
3. Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences fee Receipt
4. College fee deposit receipt
5. Provisional Eligibility Certificate
6. For in Service Candidates, study leave / resignation or NOC (As per Rule 7.6)
7. Appropriate cast Certificate for SC/ST/SEBC
8. For SEBC Candidates, Non Creamy layer Certificate of financial year pertaining to the period of application.
9. Medical Fitness Certificate

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

1. All interested candidates having the eligibility criteria mentioned above can download the Application Form from the above mentioned website. All the entries in the form should be clear, legible and correct. Please do not try to alter the form in any way. Candidates are advised to print the application form on one side of the paper only.
2. Application form fee of Rs. 1,500/- applicable at the time of Application which is nonrefundable.
3. The application must be accompanied with self-attested copies of all the required certificates.
Candidates in-service must apply through proper channel and submit “No Objection Certificate” from the present employer in format given in Application Form.
4. The completed and signed application form with all necessary enclosures should be forward to The **Admission Cell, Gujarat University of Transplantation Sciences (GUTS), Opp. Trauma Centre, Civil Hospital - Medicity Campus, Asarwa, Ahmedabad – 380 016, on or before Monday, 30th June 2025 by Registered /Speed Post / hand delivery only.** An envelope containing the Application should be superscripted **“APPLICATION FOR Master of Physiotherapy”**. **Applications sent by Fax will not be entertained.**
